Dear Friends,

Anyway, I am so excited that it is May, but before I share more about what's coming up in May and over the summer, let me share with you all that God did in April with our Mantour Conferences.

Actually, we need to go back a few days into March, because I never got to tell you about the Greater Philadelphia PA Mantour. We had an amazing time with the men in the this section. The enthusiasm among the men was amazing! We had record book sales at this event as men snatched up copies of our new book "Invincible". And that was with some of the church's men's groups already having started their study of this resource!

I always love hosting with PCC in Philadelphia! Joey Cullen, who is on our Board of Directors, always has an over the top stage display to go with the theme, and this year was no different. He and the Master's Commission students actually replicated the cliff we used in our promotional material this year. It was AWESOME!



We had a powerful Main Session as Tom Rees, the PennDel District's Men's Ministry Director brought a challenge to the men to stop being stuck on stupid. At the end of his message, we had 2 men accept Christ as their Savior (YES!), and more come forward to the altar for prayer. We had a powerful time in the workshops, and ended the day with all the men around the altars praying over the pastors who attended.

The following week was the first Saturday in April, and we wrapped up our Spring Conferences with the Northeast PA Mantour. It was our 6th year hosting with Peckville Assembly of God, and they were amazing hosts as always.

Pastor Stan Williams brought a powerful challenge for the men, and they responded in force at the altar. We had so many positive compliments about Pastor Stan's message... the men loved him! Even more important, we had 3 men accept Christ as their Savior... what a great way to wrap up the Mantour Conferences.



I was so blessed by all the men who made it a point to come up to me afterwards and thank me for the event. Each ended by saying, "We'll see you next year". That shows me they are had a good experience and want to come back.

The following week, we packed away all of our Mantour gear until September when we hold our 2nd NY Mantour Conference. We then transitioned into recording the video curriculum for our women's ministry. We ripped apart our living room, moving furniture to other rooms of the house so we could make the set for the videos. We then spent two days recording the thirteen sessions, and then I had to edit and produce the actual videos. While we had the house torn apart, we filmed the weekly shot video clips for Adessa's website. At the end, we had 13 sessions for the curriculum and 13 shorter versions for the website!

As we head into May, we will be heading to the PennDel MinistrieSummit. I hope to see all of you there! Then we will continue booking dates and locations for the 2020 Mantour Conferences. I am so excited about the theme, I can't wait to share it with you later this year.

In May we will be emptying out the garage, and then in June, we will begin converting our two car garage into MUCH NEEDED office space for our ministry. Even now, we have begun the process of emptying out the garage and moving everything. We, then, have a friend who volunteered to paint the back brick wall for us, and after that, we are ready for construction to begin.

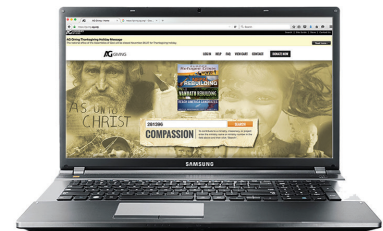
