It definitely is different and will catch your eye. I showed it to a friend, and he said, "I love it!! It definitely makes you want to find out what it's about!" I have two more chapters to go, so I'm well ahead of schedule on the book thanks to the 'Rona. Because of this, I have been able to book some extra services this summer, so it all worked out well.



This past weekend, I was happy to get back on the road to speak at Lighthouse Assembly in Breezewood, PA. It felt so good to be back in a pulpit after over three months! I had an excellent response to the message, and it was a privilege to share about no longer allowing defeat to be an option as we do whatever it takes to gain victory.

July is looking to be busy as well, as I have some services scheduled and start another publishing project with a pastor friend who is working on his 5th book. This additional work laying out and designing books has been such a financial help as we continue to raise our full missionary support budget. This extra income goes right into the ministry, helping replace some of the lost revenue from canceling Mantours because of the virus.

It has been an interesting 2020 so far, and I am looking forward to what God has for us in the second half of the year. Whatever comes, we are committed to doing "Whatever It Takes" to keep reaching men and women for Jesus and advancing God's kingdom. We believe that today and the days ahead could be some of the church's finest hours. We love you. We appreciate you.

I hope you continue reading the remainder of this newsletter as I share a valuable lesson I learned through the Covid-19 crisis.

Re-opening...what beautiful words!

I am excited to see so many churches transitioning to reopening. This time of dealing with the COVID virus has been a strain on so many churches and individuals. I am sure you learned a lot about yourself and your ministry that you didn't realize before.

I know I did. As we faced this time of quarantine where I couldn't do pulpit fill, we had to cancel a few Mantours, and we faced other new challenges and setbacks, I realized that I needed to step up even more and be even more bold and persistent in raising my missionary support via AGUS Missions. I DESPERATELY need you and your church to help us every month. As you know, I have been doing men's ministry for over twelve years, and I have led Mantour Ministries for over seven years. I KNOW our ministry has blessed the men in your church. You have seen firsthand both my faithfulness, the fruit from my ministry and my tenacity to do whatever it takes, to work as hard as necessary, and use any, and every means necessary to reach men inside and outside the church, including your own church's men.

I am now asking if you and your church would please join our monthly financial support army. Will your church help me do what I was born to do? As you know, I have been raising my AGUS Missions budget slowly as I continue doing the ministry's work. Usually, iterating missionaries would stop all ministry and raise our budget. However, neither the Penndel District nor the Assemblies of God wanted us to do this because the work we are doing is too important to stop for 18-24 months. So I have been working full time at Mantour Ministries, as well as iterating and raising support. As we work to raise our full budget, I have received a \$800 a MONTH salary, and Adessa has received \$500 a MONTH. You can see why we need you and your church's help. A yearly income of \$9,600 is well below an annual livable wage, and we need to raise the remaining 50% of our budget.

I have also been doing as much bi-vocational work as I can do with my rigorous schedule and my disability, but even that extra income has been going to fund the work of the ministry.

It is tough for me to be this open and vulnerable about my finances, but I feel I must lay my cards on the table and show you why I need your church to partner financially with me. I have done zero support raising the past three months as churches were forced to close, but now as things re-open, I need to step up my efforts. Too many men need the ministry God has called me to do. Men in churches, in prisons, in halfway houses, and Teen Challenge centers need our resources.

I hate NOTHING more than telling chaplains and prison workers we can't send them books because the virus forced us to cancel four Mantours. Without Mantour Challenge of ferings, we are limited in the number of books we can purchase and distribute. It breaks my heart to admit this, but we won't be able to give the "Whatever It Takes" book to all of the chaplains who request it without the support of more churches. But it is a reality we are facing. So I have a hard question for you. Will your church commit to supporting us for \$50, \$75, \$100, \$200-whatever amount you can give each month? It is very hard and humbling for me to ask for help, but we know we are doing the work God called us to do, and I know we can no longer do it alone. Today, I am writing to ask if your church would be willing to become a monthly supporter of mine.
