The men answered the challenge brought to them by Pastor Terry Drost to allow God to deliver them from areas of sin and weaknesses in their lives. The men came to the altar, committing themselves to going deeper with God so that God can use them even more to reach the lost in their communities.





Later that week, I had the privilege of sharing with the men at Christian Life Assembly in Camp Hill, PA. I had a great time with the men in the "Core Men" Ministry, sharing with them about the ministry I do, and also sharing my testimony and why I do what I do.

Just this past weekend, we were in Altoona, PA for our Appalachian Mt. Pa Mantour. We had a great group of guys, including men from the Altoona Salvation Army who joined us as our guests.

The men were challenged by Troy Polamalu's lookalike, Pastor Walt Smith. Pastor Walt shared a powerful message, challenging the men

to pursue the power of the Holy Spirit in their lives not just to help themselves spiritually, but to help them as they reach out to the lost. The men packed the altars, responding to Walt's message.

I enjoyed leading my workshop "Refuse to Lose: Finding God in Frustrated Plans" at both the Virginia and Appalachian Mtn. PA Mantours. The men seemed to really connect with my testimony of refusing to lose despite my disability, and they accepted the challenge to persevere and endure through any times of discouragement they face.

March looks to be an even busier month than February, as we are on the road every weekend until Palm Sunday weekend. We are believing God to move mightily in the lives of the men who come to the remainder of our Mantour Conferences! All of this is only possible thanks to your prayers and financial support. 
