Reaching Men Inside And Outside Of The Church With The Gospel!

2020 is flying along, and we are already in March. As you read this, we will be 1/4 way through our 2020 Mantour Conferences, and heading into a stretch of back-to-back-to-back-to-back conferences... that's right, four in a row! But before we head into March, allow me to share with you how God moved among men in February.

We started the month with our 7th annual Delaware Mantour. Each year, I speak in the Main Session at one Mantour, and this year it was in Delaware. We had our biggest ever turnout out at this event this year, and the men arrived excited and raring to go.

I shared a word on doing whatever it takes to break free from the sin that is entangling you. I spoke on how we have all power as God's sons to gain victory. I shared how compromise is destroying men today, and how we need to stop compromising with the world and sin. We need to pursue true holiness and pureness, following God's call on our lives. I challenged the men to resolve in their hearts to do whatever it takes to gain victory...Defeat is no longer an option!



We had men running to the altar when the challenge was given to come forward. The Holy Spirit moved so strongly at the altar that we ended up going 15 minutes over the schedule, something no one in the room noticed, but Adessa noticed and has been teasing me ever since about going so long. But it was an amazing session.



During the session, I shared how a few years back I fought so strongly against using a cane, and then using a mobility scooter, to minister. But eventually, I had to choose to do whatever it took to walk fully in God's calling. After the session, I noticed a man waiting to talk to me. He was in a wheelchair with a huge Trump 2020 bumper sticker on the back, and I knew he wanted to talk with me. He finally got his chance and he shared with me that for years he had

blamed God and was angry with God for putting him in a wheelchair, but after hearing me speak, he realized it was a blessing in disguise and he was able to deal with his anger and find peace.

What an amazing testimony! It always amazes me how God uses my disability that is such a thorn in the flesh to me to minister to other people.

Because of some bizarre scheduling and calendar issues this year, we had 28 days between conferences. I will NEVER do this again...but I made use of the time to work ahead on several projects so that they are finished and not looming over me during the conference hustle and bustle.

Now we move forward into a stretch of 4 Mantours in four week. We have never scheduled this many in a row because of the physical toll the conferences take on my body, but this year the odd calendar gave us no choice. So pray for strength and endurance as we head into this run of conferences.

Also, please pray that God moves on more churches and individuals to partner with us financially. We MUST raise the remaining 50% of our AGUS Missions support budget. It is urgent, it is necessary, and we need prayers breaking through to Heaven on our behalf.

God has expanded this ministry to men inside and outside of the church so much that we need our finances to equal the enormity of the call. It is a must. We are



reaching record numbers of men via our conferences, we are having more churches than ever use our resources, and we have expanded our prison outreach to more prisons, including into three new states! We need to grow our finances as well. Would you pray for hearts to be favorable to us in 2020?
