

Dear Friends,

October is here, my favorite month of the year. We get football, we get cooler weather, and we get to go to the Fall Honorbound conference...who could ask for more!

Before we head into October, I want to share with you about our ministry in September. I was given the honor of speaking at a men's breakfast at Mountainside Assembly of God to start the month. We had a great morning with a fabulous group of men. After I finished my message and praying for the men, I was so touched when the men gathered around and prayed for me, my health, and my work with AGUS Missions...it was a very humbling, emotional moment and a nice ending to a great morning.

In September we also launched a brand new area of ministry. In August, I spoke at a church on a Sunday morning a few hours away, and on that Sunday Adessa wasn't feeling well and stayed at home. That night I had an NFL Fantasy draft of only rookie players, I had the first and fourth picks, and my team was in desperate need of a running back. Unsure of who to pick, I decided to look for a fantasy football podcast.



I NEVER listen to podcasts, not sure why, but I just don't take the time to do it. But as I listened to this podcast on the way home (of course I waited until after I spoke lol) the Holy Spirit spoke to me and said, "Jamie, I want you to start a podcast to reach men. It is a great venue to reach more guys."

I was honestly stunned. This was nowhere on my radar, and to be honest, the last thing I needed was another project to focus on. But I knew God had spoken to me, so I decided to talk to Adessa about it. Why? Because I was SURE she would say I wasn't hearing God lol. But she didn't.



Surprisingly she was all for the idea (really, you have no idea how huge that was. I am the dreamer, Adessa is the realist.) But she was on board. I signed up for a free online class to learn how to podcast. As I got into it, I quickly realized I had none of the equipment need to record a podcast, nor did I have the money to buy it. At the same time, Adessa had taken a financial leap of faith for her ministry. I went to God and said, "If you want this podcast, you need to supply the funds."

That Sunday I spoke at a church of about 70 people, and after the service they handed me a check that covered both the podcast equipment and Adessa's leap of faith! The pastor said it was the biggest offering his church had ever given to a missionary! I knew beyond a shadow of a doubt

that it was God's will to start a podcast. So we did.

The Mantour Guy Podcast launched in September. It is a weekly podcast designed to help men grow in their walk with God. I believe

the enemy is attacking men and making the feel isolated and alone, like they are the only men still trying to serve God and follow his ways. I want this podcast to help men see they are not alone, there are other men of God serving God. I hope you check it out on our website or on iTunes. I'd really appreciate it if you subscribed to the podcast on iTunes, gave it a 5star rating and a positive review so that other men can find it.

The creation of the podcast took up most of September, along with speaking, and continuing to prepare promo materials and videos for next year's Mantour Conferences. I also made some promo videos for other men's ministries to help them grow and reach men. That's what I am about, helping other men's ministries grow, not competing with them...we're on the same team!
