As soon as this Sunday was over, I switched over to a construction worker. We could only afford to pay the contractor to do the work to a certain point, then we did all the finishing work. So for most of August, we were covered in paint, sawdust, and drywall dust as we finished our new office space project.



To be honest, we never could have finished the work without the help of good friends and ministry partners. Because of my disability, the work went slower than I would have liked, but my body could only do so much at a time. That is why I was so appreciative of the help we received.

We were so blessed by our good friends and ministry board members, Joey and Lori Cullen, when they drove two hours to spend the night painting ceilings and trimming out the paint on the top of the walls for us. I couldn't do it because of ladders and my disability, and they came while in the middle of their own ministry construction project to help. We are so grateful for this!

We were also blessed to have 4 guys from the Peckville Assembly of God Men's Ministry come down and spend a day working on the room. These amazing men trimmed out the entire room, they built our custom desks for us, and they installed the screen doors for us. It would have taken me a week or two to do everything they did in one day!

After they finished, Adessa and I worked tirelessly to get the room's final punch list done.

It was a crazy busy, exhausting month, but all the blood, sweat, and tears were worth it to finally have dedicated office space for our ministry! Look at the pictures on page 2, it looks better than we ever imagined! Plus having a second bathroom has been so great!

I didn't just work in the room all month, I still was actively doing the work of the ministry as well. I published a book for a pastor, helping him turn his words into a finished product from which others can read and learn. I worked on the NY Mantour as well as getting ready for the 2020 Mantours, hiring speakers, working on promos, etc.

August was hectic and exhausting, yet it was such a monumental month for this ministry! We never could have the possibility of office space if it wasn't for each of you who support us monthly!
