Reaching Men Inside And Outside Of The Church With The Gospel!




Dear Friends,

Happy August...how in the world is it August already? It seems like we did our last Mantour in April just yesterday, and here we are heading into August!

August is looking to be a super-busy month for us as I continue hiring speakers for 2023 (I only have a few more to go!), continue making promo materials, and start writing the new book to go with our 2023 Mantour theme! But before we get too busy with August, please let me share what God did to our ministry in July.

We were so busy in July! We started the month by celebrating my third favorite holiday of the year, the Fourth of July. I love Independence day!

We started celebrating on Saturday night by watching the fireworks in our local town. Our town rarely does the fireworks actually on Fourth of July weekend, so that was a great blessing. I ask you to please seek God and be open to His prompting.


